Our Sixth Form Careers Programme focuses on three key themes: career readiness, leadership, and transition to adulthood. It builds on the KS4 Plan and Prepare journey and prepares students for life beyond college. Activities are mapped to Gatsby Benchmarks and incorporate Skills Builder essential skills.

Year 12 – Career Readiness and Leadership

Students develop leadership and employability skills through employer engagement, university visits, and exposure to work-place environments. The focus is on building confidence, communication, and planning for future pathways.
